Rules for Prelims:

- Maximum number of teams selected for finals from an institute will depend on the number of participating teams from each institute for prelims.

Number participating teams from each institute	Maximum number of teams selected for finals
Upto 10	2
11-19	3
20 or more	4

- Prelims will consist of 25 single correct MCQs to be answered in the portal and 5 subjective whose solutions are to be scanned and uploaded onto the portal itself.
- The portal will open 5 mins prior to the exam and the exam will start at 10:30 am, 18 November, Sunday.
- The portal will close at 12:30 pm.
- Teams need to save and submit their responses before 12:30, else their answers won't be accepted.
- All questions do not have the same weightage. The marks will be mentioned along with the questions.
- For subjective questions, teams will be assessed on the basis of their approach for the question along with answer.
- In case of any disputes/discrepancies, the organizer's decision will be final and binding.
- The organizer's reserve the rights to change any of the above rules as they deem fit. Change in rules, if any will be highlighted on the website and notified to the registered teams.
- Teams selected for finals will be notified through mail.
